Features finely cut palmate, dissected leaves and cascading branching habit. Leaves emerge red in the spring, mature to dark reddish-purple in the summer. In late summer the leaves turn green then to a bright crimson red-orange for the fall.

Korean maple is an upright, deciduous, small tree or large shrub that matures over time to 20' tall with a similar but sometimes wider spread. It is native to forested areas in Korea and China. Brilliant red and orange fall color.
