

Roses

ANTIQUÉ

'Madame Plantier'

Fragrant clusters of flat, very double blooms of pure white with a distinctive green eye. Regular pruning encourages a bushy, spreading plant. Grows 4-6'.

CLIMBING

'Blaze'

Bright clusters of red flowers. Most popular climber nationwide. Blooms profusely. Grows 10-15'.

'Climbing Cecile Brunner'

Moderately fragrant, climbing polyantha with clear pink blooms. Blooms mostly in spring on old wood, 8-10' tall.

'Climbing Purple Splash'

A whole new color in climbers! Has exceptional coloring with its speckled rich purple petals and vividly green leaves. This extremely attractive climber loves to soak in full sun and can grow up to 6 feet tall.

'Don Juan'

One of the most fragrant climbers. Large velvety-red blooms throughout the summer. Grows to 8-10'.

'Florentina'

This rose was chosen for its exceptional vigor, non-stop blooming habit and blossoms that won't wilt in the heat. It puts out flush after flush of gorgeous, ruby red blooms all season long. Exceptional disease resistance and award-winning as well.

'Good Day Sunshine'

Good Day Sunshine will give you color galore with big clusters of ruffled flowers saturated with the purest of deep yellow color and the yellow tones hold well through the life of the flower with virtually no fade.

'Iceburg'

Climbing form of the popular white Iceburg rose. Grows to 9'.

'Jasmina'

Very healthy, pastel shades of pink, turns deep mauve in center, very full nostalgic bloom. Very floriferous and fragrant blooms in large clusters which often last for many weeks. Gold medal winner in international competition.

'Joseph's Coat'

Large, double, slightly fragrant, yellow and red multicolored flowers. Vigorous pillar with recurrent bloom. Grows to 10'.

'New Dawn'

Double light-pink roses. Disease resistant. Grows to 10'.

'Royal America'

Born in small clusters, on old and new wood, ivory blooms crown this disease resistant climber. Grows 10-12'.

'White Dawn'

Medium fragrance, Ever-blooming white blooms from late spring to frost, 6-8' tall.

'William Baffin'

This is one tough rose with proven cold hardiness, but this free-flowering bush, which sets clusters of 30 flat-petaled deep strawberry-pink blooms, is as pretty as it is tough. Grows 8-10' tall.

'Yellow Blaze'

Eye popping yellow climber with clusters of crisp blooms on massive plants. Ideal for fence or arbor. Disease resistant.

DAVID AUSTIN

'Abraham Darby'

Soft peachy-pink inside with pale yellow reverse, strong fragrance, grows to 5' tall, canes can be trained against a wall or trellis. Zone 4

'Charlotte' - Own Root

Light creamy-yellow medium-sized cupped blooms are very double and strongly fragrant. Grows to 3'. Zone 4

'Crown Princess Margareta'

Large, deep apricot-orange blossoms grow on a tall, gently arching shrub, providing a glorious perfumed display. Perfect for growing along a fence line. Grows to 6'. Zone 4

'Darcey Bussell' - Own Root

Deep, rich crimson rosettes. Excellent repeating and disease resistance. Fruity fragrance. Short, bushy growth. Grows to 2'

'Gertrude Jekyll'

Beautiful, rich pink rosettes with the quintessential Old Rose fragrance: superb, strong and perfectly balanced. Very healthy and reliable. Repeat flowering.

'Graham Thomas' - Own Root

Rich yellow coloring, tea-rose fragrance.

'Harlow Carr'

Perfectly formed, pure pink rosette blooms, which are produced very freely and have a strong Old Rose fragrance. Attractive, bushy growth. Exceptionally healthy.

'Huntington Rose'

Medium pink heavily petaled flowers with a warm, old rose fragrance. Excellent, healthy shrub that grows to 4'. Zone 5

'L. D. Braithwaite' - Own Root

A great red landscaping variety, with deep crimson flowers and pleasing bushy growth habit. The flowers open wide and are lightly cupped, holding their color well without fading. Very fragrant. Grows to 5'. Zone 4

'MARY ROSE'

Pink blooms, old Damask-rose fragrance, 4' tall and flowers repeat.

'Olivia Rose Austin'

Flowers are of beautiful Old Rose formation, commencing as prettily cupped buds and gradually opening to become shallowly cupped rosettes of three and a half inches across. The colour is a lovely soft shade of pink and it has a strong, pleasing fragrance with distinct fruity tints.

'Scepter'd Isle' - Own Root

A charming rose which bears numerous, cupped flowers, with yellow stamens visible within. Growth is rather upright, with its flowers held above the foliage. Powerful fragrance. Grows 4'. Zone 4

'Sharifa Asma'

Flowers are a delicate blush pink, paling to almost white on the outer petals. There is a distinctive and beautiful fragrance with fruity notes reminiscent of white grapes and mulberry. A short shrub with bushy, upright growth. Grows 4'. Zone 4

'Sophy's Rose'

Attractive light red colouring combines well with most colour schemes. This is a very productive rose suitable for rose beds and towards the front of a border. Zone 4

'St. Swithun' - Own Root

Flowers freely and repeats very quickly. There is a strong pure myrrh fragrance. A vigorous variety, 'St. Swithun' forms a tall shrub with slightly stiff, bushy growth – ideal for the back of the border. Zone 4

'Strawberry Hill' - Own Root

Pure rose-pink blooms of superb quality. Superb myrrh fragrance. An excellent, tall very healthy shrub. Grows to 4'. Zone 5

'The Lark Ascending'

Light apricot, semi-double, cupped flowers. Very healthy and vigorous. Grows to 5'. Zone 5

'The Poet's Wife'

Flowers of an unfading, strong yellow. Their formation is most pleasing, having a neat outer ring of petals enclosing an informal group of petals within. The growth is low and naturally rounded, making it an ideal rose for a position towards the front of the border.

'Tranquility'

Most exquisite old fashioned 4" blooms (petals 60+) whose coloring is a delicate peaceful pink shading to near white at the petal edges. The lovely flowers have elegance and dignity and are blessed with a strong intoxicating rich myrrh perfume. The blooms are produced both individually and in small clusters on a bushy compact plant whose bronze red young foliage mature to a rich dark green.

DAVID AUSTIN CLIMBING

'Benjamin Britten' - Own Root

Very double, cupped flowers are very fragrant. Interesting medium-sized orange-red blooms are suitable for cutting. Grows to 5'.

'Boscobel'

Beautiful flowers of rich salmon coloring. A medium-strong myrrh fragrance. A vigorous, healthy shrub of medium size. Zone 5

'James Galway' - Own Root

Unusual neatness to the flowers. Warm pink in the center, paling gradually towards the edges. Medium Old Rose fragrance. Strong, stems are almost thornless. Grows up to 8'.

'Teasing Georgia' - Own Root

Short Climber with perfectly formed, fully-cupped, fragrant flowers with honey colored centers framed by lighter outer petals. Vigorous, disease-resistant plants grow to 4'.

'The Generous Gardener' - Own Root

Large, cup-shaped, delicate, pale pink blooms. Old rose, musk and myrrh scent. Extremely healthy. Grows to 10'. Zone 4

FLORIBUNDA

'Ebb Tide'

The mysterious dusky deep plum purple color and the strong spicy clove fragrance will grab your attention and never let go.

'Europeana'

Slight fragrance. Dark red blooms, exceptionally long lasting. Medium height.

'Iceberg'

The Iceberg rose bush is my absolute favorite white rose shrub. A Gold Medal floribunda rose winner, iceberg roses deserve a lot of praise. One of the best roses of all time. Has pure white rain resistant, shapely blooms that are long lasting, both as a cut flower and as a bush.

'Livin Easy'

Frilly orange-apricot blooms will have you enjoying the view, but its black spot resistance will have you livin' easy. Excellent for the landscape and mass plantings.

'Love Song'

These lovely lavender old-fashioned flowers just seem to last and last without turning a lurid gray. Underneath all that beauty is a bushy rounded plant clothed with great rich green leaves, but, you may have to dig through all the blooms to find them. It'll be love at first sight.

'Marmalade Skies'

Captivatingly colorful tangerine orange blooms in large clusters add a tropical color to the garden. AARS winner. Grows to 3'.

'Playboy'

Glossy dark green foliage highlight the fiery bright orange blooms that have the scent of fresh sliced apples.

'Rainbow Sorbet'

Edged in deep pink, this golden yellow beauty blooms early and abundantly - and continues all season long. Remarkable disease-resistance and very winter hardy. Grows to 5'.

'Summer Romance'

Floribunda rose with dark pink buds and quartered and cup-shaped intensely fragrant flowers on a vigorous, bushy plant with dense lightly glossy, dark-green foliage.

'Walking on Sunshine'

2011 AARS winner. Tight clusters of fragrant, bright yellow buds open to ruffled blossoms that age gracefully. Fantastic bloom production on this attractive rounded bushy habit. Super-glossy disease resistant foliage. A great rose for beginners.

GRANDIFLORA

'Dick Clark'

This rose puts on a show with a dazzling display of ever-changing color. The unique blooms begin as black-red buds, open in swirls of creamy centers and cherry pink margins, blush to burgundy and finish dark red. Moderate cinnamon spice scent.

'Madame Anisette'

A cream-colored large bloom with an extraordinary scent. The habit is upright. The foliage is abundant with large, bright green leaves. Easy to grow and a repeat bloomer. This rose is perfect for the back of a perennial bed or as a specimen plant. Excellent for cutting flowers.

'Mt. Hood'

A majestic and awe-inspiring rose. Soft drifts of snowy white hues atop masses of high-centered blooms give this bush the snow-capped appearance that inspired its name. Captivating beauty, excellent vigor, and good disease resistance make this rose an award winner.

'Queen Elizabeth'

The "Royal Matriarch of Grandifloras". This dawn pink regal beauty is known all over the kingdoms of the world. A mature bush can produce hundreds of cut flowers a season.

HYBRID TEA

'Chicago Peace'

Rich, shimmering pink blooms with canary yellow and often copper tones at the base of petals. Tall plants.

'Dark Desire'

Exceptionally fragrant cup-shaped double petal count Hybrid Tea blooms with a unique violet red color. Foliage is bright glossy green on a vigorous, healthy shrub.

'Dolly Parton'

It is noted for its extremely fragrant, rich orange-red flowers that appear in late May and repeat bloom in flushes throughout the season. Flowers are fully double. Each flower typically has 35-40 petals.

'Luscious'

The warm and embracing blend of rich magenta and glowing amber will seduce the mind and capture hearts. Lush, vigorous growth, long stems and wonderful fragrance.

'Mikado'

Red blend hybrid tea rose. Flowers brilliant luminous light scarlet, suffused with yellow at base. Mild fragrance. Full exhibition bloom form. Blooms in flushes throughout the season. Tall, upright. Medium, semi-glossy, medium green foliage.

'Miranda Lambert'

With its phenomenal fragrance, big blossoms and hot pink color, this fragrant Hybrid Tea features petals of saturated cerise and large, elegant buds over five inches in diameter. Grows 4-5'.

'Mr. Lincoln'

Heavy fragrance, long lasting, deep-red flowers. Tall plant.

'Pink Peace'

Magnificent deep pink blooms, intense rose fragrance, and elegant long stems.

'Sacred Heart'

An inspiring crimson red rose with extra large blooms held on strong stems. The combination of glorious blooms and vigorous habit makes this rose a heavenly addition to the garden.

'Sunshine Daydream'

Each flowering stem bears up to eight 3½-inch blooms of soft butter-yellow that matures to a rich shade of cream over time. Superb disease resistance keeps the glossy dark green foliage healthy.

RUGOSA

'Pink Grootendorst'

Step back in time with these small clusters of fringe-petaled pink rosettes. Rarely out of flower, this hardy and easy to grow bush rewards with very little effort.

'Robusta'

As the name implies, this is an extremely vigorous and floriferous rose, providing trusses of long pointed buds and brilliant red flowers all season. Moderate fragrance, grow to 6-7'.

'Sir Thomas Lipton'

Pure white, very double and intensely fragrant blooms. Flowers recurrently. Grows to 6-8'.

'Therese Bugnet'

Exceptionally hardy, large flat single blooms open to deep lilac rose and fade to shades of pink; spice fragrance. Unsurpassed disease resistance, 5-6' tall.

'Topaz Jewel'

Reblooming yellow, clusters of 3 ½-4" blooms all season long, dense bushy shrub that grows 5' tall & 7' wide.

SHRUB

'Blushing Knock Out'

A maintenance-free rose that continually produces self-cleaning single light pink flowers that become soft shell pink as they mature. Unsurpassed resistance to black spot disease. An excellent low hedge or accent.

'Coral Drift'

Bright coral-orange blooms cover this small mounding shrub. Fully winter hardy and disease resistant.

'Double Knock Out'

This carefree landscape rose has all of the same wonderful characteristics of its sister seedling, 'Knock Out' with twice as many petals per flower. Cherry red blossoms and deep purple fall foliage coloring provide your garden with three seasons of interest. Grows to 3-4'.

'Double Pink Knock Out'

Just as hardy and prolific as the original Knock Out, and covered with bright pink double flowers that mature to light pink. Grows to 3'. Black spot resistant.

'Knock Out'

The hottest new shrub rose to hit the market, and it comes with AARS honors. It's absolutely carefree, never stops performing, and its combination of fluorescent cherry-red flowers and moss green foliage make it a real traffic stopper. Grows to 3'.

'Lavender Crush'

Grape to lavender tones blended with a reverse of creamy white. Clusters of full, old-fashioned flowers bow down on graceful arching stems to invite you to take in the intense citrus blossom and rose aroma. Grows 5-7'.

'Lemon Fizz'

Features brilliant deep-yellow non-fading flowers with glossy green foliage. Easy to grow, this exceptionally disease tolerant shrub is a carefree choice for gardens and landscaping.

'Louis Riel'

Small single white flowers on disease resistant plants with cool grey-blue leaves. This Rosa rubrifolia hybrid is non recurrent. Grows to 5'.

'Miracle on the Hudson'

Named after the heroic crew and passengers of flight 1549 that survived the emergency landing in the Hudson River in 2009. Large semi double red blooms on plants with phenomenal black spot and powdery mildew resistance. Mild fragrance.

'Nearly Wild'

Blooms unfold into large, single-form pink flowers with a sweet fragrance. The show continues all season long. Grows to 2-3'.

'Peach Drift'

One of the more floriferous dwarf shrubs available with soft peach blooms that cover the plant all season long. Works well in the perennial garden and has very strong disease resistance.

'Persian Yellow'

The very cold-tolerant shrubby plant gives an unbelievable display of eye-popping yellow color. The double flower form was quite a rare treasure in its day. Hardy. Best in harsher climates.

'Sunny Knock Out'

Disease resistant dark green foliage in an upright habit. From spring to frost it covers itself with bright yellow, single blooms that eventually change to creamy white with age.

'The Fairy'

Although this rose starts blooming later than almost any other rose, once it starts, it gives a fantastic show of flowers for weeks on end. The lovely rosette formed flowers are made up of many tiny petals. The flowers arrives in dainty sprays of blooms all over the bush, all in an even light pink color.
